

ATTENTION ALL DIVERS

- ❑ Under the authority delegated to the Kwajalein Atoll Local Government (KALGOV) by the RMI Historic Preservation Office, under the Ministry of the Internal and Social Welfare, effective September 30, 1998, diving permits will be required to dive within 500 feet of any prehistoric/ historic submerged resources.
- ❑ Applications for either an individual dive permit (\$50.00) or a tour guide permit (\$150.00) can be obtained at the KALGOV Custom Office at the Dock Security Checkpoint (DSC), 5-3359, Monday, Wednesday, Friday, between 4 and 6 pm.
- ❑ Personal checks or cash will be accepted along with the application. Receipts will be given and can be used until permits are issued.
- ❑ Actual permits will be issued at the same office after the dive permit application a fee have been paid, the instructional video has been viewed, and the Dive Permit Affidavit has been signed.
- ❑ A list of approved applicants will be posted at the DSC Custom Office every Tuesday.
- ❑ Always have this card with you when you go out diving. Save your receipt for card replacement, which can be obtained for a \$2.00 fee.
- ❑ Dive Permits can not be transferred to another individual.
- ❑ Any violations to the above instructions may result in loss of diving privileges, as well as criminal prosecution resulting in a fine of up to \$10,000 and/or six (6) months of imprisonment.
